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Introduction

Welcome to *Framework English B*. This is book 2 in a series of English language textbooks designed to improve learners' communicative and cognitive skills. Based on the aims and assessment criteria of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), this book follows CEFR's goals for developing learners' language skills. CEFR's assessment criteria is categorized into proficiency levels (A1-C2), and this action-based book primarily targets A2-B1 levels. Vocabulary has been selected largely from the A2-B2 CEFR-J levels; a CEFR informed word list designed for Asian learners of English. Book 2 builds on book 1 by targeting higher levels of CEFR-J rated vocabulary and CEFR rated grammar. The selected language has been allocated within 6 topic-based modules of personal, social, educational and professional relevance for learners, by covering topics such as biographies, personalities and predictions. In doing so, learners can develop interpersonal and intrapersonal skills by understanding how people can communicate effectively, as well as knowing their own strengths and weaknesses, and identifying their potential career paths. Furthermore, these modules are looked at from international viewpoints so learners can improve their understanding of multiculturalism and express their opinions about different cultures.

Each module follows a systematic structure. Learners are first provided with learning goals, followed by a progression of tasks and activities that allow learners to practice and develop communicative and cognitive skills. Each module also provides visual graphic organizers that help learners to extract key information from complex listening and reading texts. Graphic organizers are also used to help students develop strategies for planning and organizing their thoughts clearly for productive writing. At the end of each module, learners complete "Can-do" statements which reflect the goals outlined at the start of the module, enabling them to assess their strengths and weaknesses. There are also three review units that consist of research projects where learners answer research questions by collecting and reporting on data using key language features of the modules. In doing so, learners develop important cognitive skills such as analyzing information, reasoning, inferring, and displaying visual data.

The communicative and cognitive skills developed from using *Framework English B* can benefit life-long learning not only in relation to students' English studies, but also other areas of their academic studies, as well as their future careers.

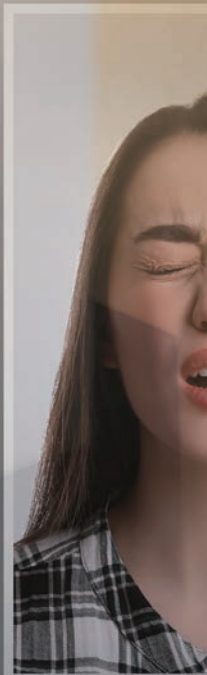
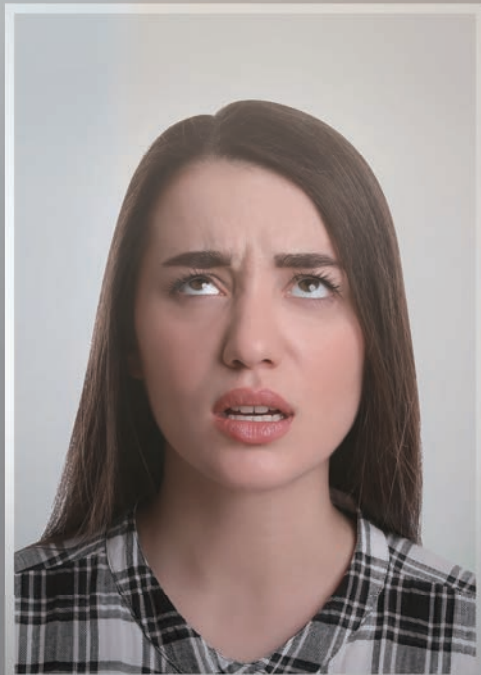
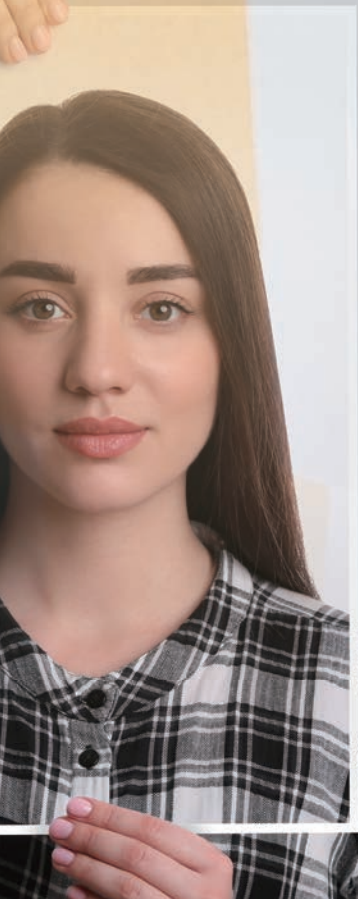

Natsume Sōseki was a Japanese novelist. He is well known around the world for the novels he wrote, like *Kokoro*, *Botchan* and *I Am a Cat*. He was born in Tokyo, Japan. He graduated from the University of Tokyo, and at first he became a school teacher. Many people think he was the greatest writer in recent Japanese history. He had blood type A. Although a wonderful writer, Sōseki was also self-centered, easily stressed and often depressed.

Elizabeth II, born 21 April, 1926, was Queen of the United Kingdom from 1952 until she died on 8 September 2022. Elizabeth was married Prince Philip, who died in 2021. Together, they had four children, eight grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. Her eldest son became King Charles III when she died. Her blood type was O. She cared a lot about her role as queen and about her family. She was optimistic and had a relaxed sense of humor.

Barack Obama was the first African-American president of the United States. He was president from 2009 to 2017 and won the Nobel Prize for Peace in 2009. He was born in Hawaii on August 4, 1961 to an American mother and a Kenyan father. He grew up in Jakarta, Indonesia before returning to America and studying Law at university. Known for being calm, charming, and highly intelligent, like many people with AB blood type.

John Lennon was born in Liverpool, UK, on October 9, 1940. He became world-famous as a singer and guitarist with the Beatles, and for the amazing songs he wrote with Paul McCartney. He was killed in front of his apartment in New York in 1980 at the age of 40. He had two children and was married to Yoko Ono, his second wife, when he died. With O blood type, he had an easygoing, imaginative personality and was loyal to friends and family. He could be jealous at times.

Chiaki Mukai is a Japanese physician and JAXA astronaut, born on May 6, 1952 in Tatebayashi, Gunma Prefecture. She was the first Japanese woman in space. She is very intelligent, graduating from Keio Girls Senior High School in Tokyo, and receiving her doctorate in medicine from Keio University School of Medicine in 1977. She is very ambitious, hardworking and never gives up her dreams. As with other A blood types, she is also a perfectionist.

Edson Arantes do Nascimento, known as **Pelé**, was born on October 23, 1940, in Brazil. He had B blood type. Many think he was the greatest soccer player of all time. With Pelé, Brazil won the World Cup in 1958 (when he was only 17 years old), 1962 and 1970. After retiring, Pelé composed music, wrote books about his life, and served as Brazil's minister of sports. He died on December 29, 2022. Famous for his speed and skill on the soccer pitch, he had an outgoing and creative nature.

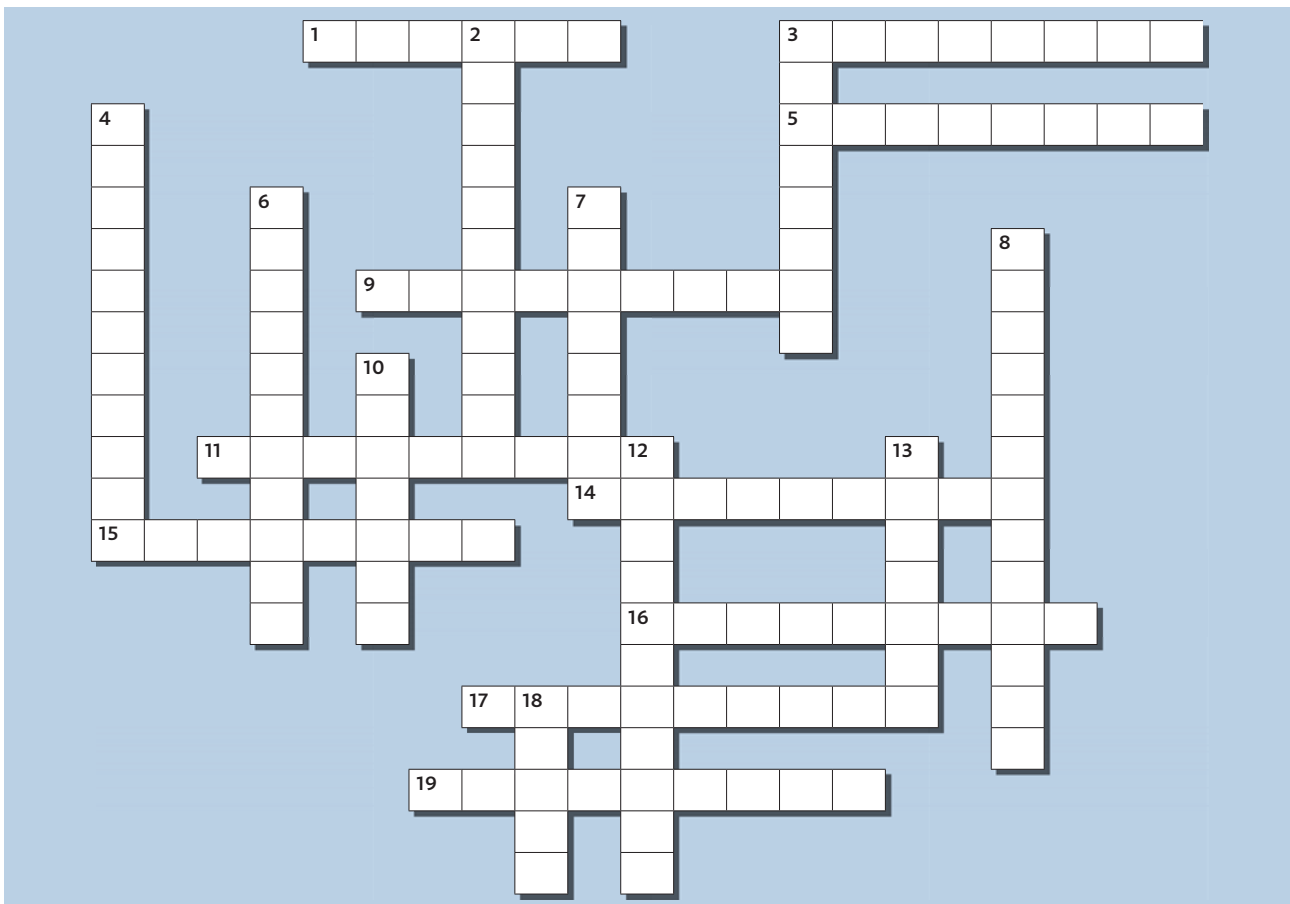
